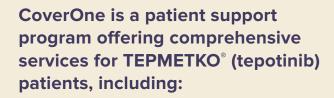

Access and Coverage Support

CoverOne specialists help patients and their care teams understand how TEPMETKO® (tepotinib) may be covered under the patient's individual insurance plan.

Support includes:

- Verifying insurance benefits to determine coverage and help patients understand potential out-of-pocket costs for TEPMETKO
- Helping to support the prior authorization process to facilitate timely access to treatment
- Navigating the appeals process with patients and their healthcare team if coverage is denied

To request a benefits verification or assistance, patients are encouraged to work with their healthcare provider to complete the CoverOne Enrollment Form.

TEPMETKO is dispensed through authorized specialty pharmacies. The NDCs for TEPMETKO are provided below and may be required for insurance or prior authorization documentation:

Financial Assistance Programs

CoverOne offers a range of financial support options to help eligible patients access TEPMETKO® (tepotinib).

Eligible patients with private commercial insurance may pay as little as \$0 for each prescription, up to a maximum of \$15,000 per year.

CoverOne Bridge Program

To help patients begin treatment when it matters most, CoverOne offers a Bridge Program that provides the first prescription of TEPMETKO® (tepotinib) at no cost to eligible patients experiencing insurance delays.

Patients must meet the following criteria to qualify:

- Be new to treatment with a prescription for TEPMETKO
- Have a diagnosis from their physician that matches the FDA-approved indication for TEPMETKO
- Have insurance coverage (e.g., through a commercial insurer or a federal health care program)
- Experience a delay of at least 5 business days in receiving an insurance coverage determination

To apply for the Bridge Program, patients are encouraged to work with their healthcare provider to complete the CoverOne Enrollment Form.

CoverOne Patient Assistance Program (PAP)[†]

Patients without insurance or coverage for TEPMETKO may qualify to receive their medication at no cost.

To apply for PAP, patients should:

- Complete the CoverOne Enrollment Form with their healthcare provider
- Provide the required financial information
- Submit all information before treatment begins, as assistance cannot be applied to treatment already received

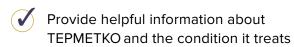

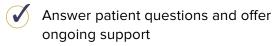


Nursing Support
